Dear Parents,

Here at Fairfield First we aim to give our children a wide variety of experiences. One way in which we feel that we can supplement our already broad curriculum is by offering a variety of after school clubs, throughout the school year. We will aim to include a range of activities, appropriate for our children, across the age ranges. These clubs will be organised and run by a member of school staff or qualified Sports Coach. All clubs will begin at the end of the school day, 3.15pm and run until **4.15pm**, when we expect children to be collected promptly from a particular area of the school. Unfortunately, some clubs may require a small payment, to cover the costs of additional resources – we will always endeavour to keep this at an absolute minimum.

To ensure these clubs are of a consistently high standard numbers will be limited; this will be dependent on the type of activity and the resources available. Places will be allocated using our online booking system. To book a space for your child at one of the above clubs:

There are 2 ways to find the booking system:

You will then need to enter just a few simple personal details. These details should be of the person whom we hold as the main contact in school (for 95% of our children this is mum). Please ensure that the information you input is the same as the information that we hold in school (e.g. Ms/Miss/Mr etc). Booking for these clubs will open on **Friday 29th March at 7pm** and will close on Friday 5th April. By booking on the first session, you will be guaranteed a place for all sessions – we do expect those children gaining a place to attend every possible session. Please do not be too disappointed if you do not get the club your child would like, as some will be repeated throughout the year but please keep checking the Booking Website, in case someone relinquishes a place. Upon gaining a place at a club, should there be a charge, please send this into school, in a sealed, named envelope as soon as possible. We will remind those people gaining a place via text, when we return in January.

We hope that these clubs will prove popular and offer further opportunities and experiences for all of our children.
