### Nature of support/funding 2017/2018

- Additional intervention teacher to support all year groups, to provide targeted teaching and learning to focus pupils, as a result of data analysis.
- To provide intervention support to targeted pupils, to remove barriers to learning.
- Enhance teaching and learning within the Curriculum, through subsidising trips and visits, linked to the Fairfield Curriculum.
- Enhance attendance levels, through the development of individual and group rewards for good levels of attendance across school.
- Additional After-School Club provision, to support healthy lifestyles and the wider curriculum.
- Develop opportunities to embed the School Curriculum, via initiatives like gardening club, local visits and community opportunities.
- Learning outside the classroom nurture groups.
